CRITERIA FOR BARR MEMBERSHIP - MULTI-TERRAIN RACES

On behalf of the organising committee I confirm that this event does conform to the following basic definitions and requirements thus rendering it eligible to be classed as multi-terrain;

1. There is a **minimum** of 30% up to a **maximum** of 75% of the course upon tarmac roads.
2. The types of terrain used pose no threat of hazard from land or water – e.g. tides, falling rocks, rivers, cliff footpaths, narrow towpaths etc. The course adheres to established paths having a width and surface suitable for the number of entrants.
3. Any man-made obstacles introduced by the organisers do not constitute a potential danger to the competitors.
4. Because of the nature of the event action will be taken to ensure the security of all runners, particularly those who may become detached from the rest of the field. The "sweep" arrangements will take into account the nature of the terrain and access to the course, the course distance, the possible weather conditions and the need to have available first aid,
